#### Fiscal Year 2022 – 2023 Year End Financial Report.

**General:** The Branch ended the fiscal year in a positive financial position. Revenues stood at \$434,145.28 with expenditures of \$393,686.32, leaving a profit of \$40,458.96 in the General Account. Of note is that \$40K was transferred to the Building and Land Fund.

Excluding bar and club house inventories, the Branch as of 31 May, 2023, retains cash assets in the following amounts:

Building and Land Fund: \$177,354.81

Bingo Account \$32,709.00

Nevada Account \$982.31

Building Account \$27,646.72

General Account \$96,091.87

**Ways and Means**: Regular and various fundraising activities were undertaken and have largely been successful. In particular, the Branch Virtual Garage Sale administered by Cmrd Angel Guy and the Golf Tournament administered by Cmrd Sereda were highly successful.

**Bar Operations:** Bar sales are in accordance with expectations, while maintaining 52% profit margin. This provides the necessary income to maintain Branch operations. All bar staff are congratulated for their support of the Branch.

**Hospitality and Entertainment:** Friday Night Dinners continue to be very successful and profitable, often selling out. The various menus and entertainments offered at a reasonable price are attracting members and guests to the Branch. The Hospitality Committee is to be commended for their support.

**Special Events:** The inclusion of the Wednesday afternoon Open Mic programme has been of significant success, drawing more that 120 patrons to each of the two monthly events, bolstering both bar and food sales. The Hospitality Committee is to be commended.

**Hall Rental:** The hall rental continues to be a major source of revenue for the Branch, reaching \$12,292.19 for the year. Our Hall Rental OPI, Cmrd Cathy Pearen, is commended for successfully managing this activity.

Housing: No major projects were undertaken.

In conclusion, the Branch continues to remain financially healthy, ensuring major costs are covered and facilities are properly maintained. This due in large part to the many volunteers that support the Branch.

**Recommendations:** In support of the Branch's major initiative to build a new clubhouse, it is recommended to transfer \$40K to the Building And Land Fund. This will help to bolster the Fund and leave sufficient funds to support general Branch operations in the General Account.
