Information for Nominators

Who can nominate:

 Nominations can be submitted by a designated representative from an Ontario branch of The Royal Canadian Legion.

Who are eligible to be nominated:

Veterans who are residents of Ontario

Who should be nominated:

- Individual veterans who have demonstrated significant, sustained contributions to their community as demonstrated by exceptional community service. For example, but not restricted to:
 - Volunteerism with community or regional impact
 - Volunteerism with provincial impact (not mandatory).
- Nominations must detail how the veteran's continuous service led to positive impacts and contributed to improved outcomes in their community/area/region.
 - Please keep a record of why you selected this veteran highlighting their contributions and impacts to your community.
 - You may be asked by the Ministry of Citizenship and Multiculturalism for information about your nominee.

Submitting a nomination:

- Choose Ontario Veterans Community Service Excellence Award from the list of honours and awards

- Confirm and submit the nomination
